## **PAINTING NOTES & TIPS**

### **DARK REDS & YELLOWS:**

These two colour ranges can be challenging with respect to application, particularly if the colour is bright as opposed to muted. Some important information about painting with dark colours:

Very rich reds and yellow generally require an accent primer. Multiple coats should be expected after the accent primer (2-4 depending on colour and application).

imperfections (including drywall patches) on the walls become highlighted with dark colours. Excess light on the wall will further exaggerate imperfections.

A top quality roller sleeve with the proper pile is required as it will disperse more product on the wall (10-13mm).

Apply liberally. The biggest application error encountered is usually lack of product.

Do not back roll (for more information see winter painting tips).

Painting with any colour should always be done with consistency, rolling from the top of the wall to the bottom on the final stroke before you reload your roller. And remember, as mentioned above-do not back roll!
